The pick: Adobe Guadalupe Vintage Dinner at Bracero

Why it rates: How do you say crème de la crème in Spanish? [Adobe Guadalupe](#), arguably the best winery in Mexico's Valle de Guadalupe, will be pouring rare, older vintages and current releases at [Bracero](#) in Little Italy on Oct. 4. Bracero chef/owner Javier Plascencia, the biggest name in San Diego's thriving Cali-Baja scene, will pair a special menu with the wines. Adobe Guadalupe's bold reds, all named for archangels, are known for their flavor and finesse. Same could be said for Plascencia's cooking. Combined, the two should be heavenly.
